

## MEETING OF THE LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION

Transfers of ownership, transfers of location, transfers of classification and new applicants were approved except as noted on the attached lists.

It was moved by the Chairman, seconded by Commissioner Knight and carried: :

"That the Sebewaing Brewing Company be granted the right to have the Bay City Brewing Company bottle their product subject to Federal regulations."

It was moved by Chairman McFarland, seconded by Commissioner Gormely and carried:

"That the Birmingham Public Schools be issued an M permit."

Mr.Glassen, attorney, A.A.Smith and Mr.Sepeter of the Club Tally-Ho appeared before the Commission. New by-laws have been drawn up; copy of the agreement between the Club and Mr.Sepeter; copy of lease submitted.

It was moved by Commissioner Knight, seconded by the Chairman and carried:

"That a license be granted as soon as the Club has complied with certain recommendations."

Mr.Knight presented a list of slow moving cordials to be put on sale, the cost per case to be around \$14.00. Mr.McFarland ordered that

the list be marked "ones to be sold" and "ones to be returned" before any recommendation is made.

Special cases were presented by Mr. Parrish and approved as shown on the attached list.

A list of applicants for wholesale beer license and Mfg. Indust. presented by Mr. Shea was ordered approved.

It was moved by Commissioner Youngblood, seconded by Chairman McFarland and carried:
